DYE LANE AND QUARRY ROAD RESURFACING

■ Following contact from local residents about the state of the road in Dye Lane Cllr Lloyd contacted Stockport Council and officers have stated that Dye Lane is programmed to be resurfaced with Quarry Road, this is expected to be early 2018. However the Officers have stated this could be before the end of 2017.

Nicki Baines Conservative Candidate for Bredbury Green and Romiley said, "These Road repairs in Dye Lane and Quarry Road will make a big improvement for residents travelling along these roads and for people visiting the Swimming Baths and the Arc where I am a volunteer. I will be monitoring their progress once the work begins."

WILLIAM WRAGG WELCOMES £1.3 BILLION EXTRA SCHOOLS' FUNDING

■ Since my first day in Parliament, back in 2015, I have been committed to fighting for fairer funding for schools in our local area.

It is crucial to ensure we provide our children with the best quality education. Since I became an MP I have consistently campaigned for the Government to improve education funding, how effectively it is used, and to secure a better deal for our local schools.

I am delighted that the Government has now committed to raise school

funding to new record levels. The Government will add £4 billion to the overall schools budget by 2022, which will raise the total budget to £45 billion - a greater than real terms increase each year.

I recently met with the Education Secretary Justine Greening, and was very encouraged by her announcement of a new £1.3 billion boost to core school funding over the next two years. This means school funding will be £2.6 billion higher in 2019-20 compared to 2017-18. The total schools' budget

will also be protected, and a fairer funding formula will be introduced so that similar pupils get the same funding, no matter their location.

I will continue to do all I can to ensure that local schools across Stockport continue to benefit from this boost.
