
### 1 YVONNE'S VISION FOR MARPLE TOWN CENTRE

Back in 2016, Windlehurst Area Living Streets (WALS) organised a campaign to look at innovative solutions to mitigate speed, but were ignored by Stockport Council and old-hat speed cushions were seemingly the only option they would consider.

Enough is enough. Whilst the speed tables such as those on the Keswick road junction seem to be doing the job, local residents have reported terrible damages to cars because of the speed cushions on Windlehurst Road.

# FOR STRINES AND MILL GREEN

Yvonne Collier has been contacted by concerned local residents who have been short changed by internet providers.

Last year, a company was contracted to provide decent internet speeds for local residents and business. Unfortunately, tests show the speeds received in Strines fall way back compared to Marple and High Lane.
